# 10 Reasons Why Your Business Needs Social Media

### (Yes, even YOUR business)

Do I "Like" or "Tweet"? "Pin" or "Check-in"? What does the "#" symbol mean? And why would I "+1"? If you're like me, the thought of the Social Media world is incredibly intimidating. There seems to be a new network popping up almost weekly. Facebook, Twitter, Flicker, Tumblr, Linked In, Instagram, Foursquare; the list goes on. These networks aren't just social gathering sights anymore. They have become the new way to market and promote your business.

So what is Social Media and what can it do for your business? Frankly speaking, Social Media is a channel for your business to connect to other business, current customers and potential new customers. Traditional advertising such as television, print and radio ads basically had a one-way connection to your audience. Social Media creates an opportunity for you to have a two-way conversation and interact with people on a day-to-day basis. By using these networks, you can connect with your current and potential customers on an emotional level which creates a bond between you.

Let's look at 10 reasons for your business to be using Social Media:

**1) Branding & creating a buzz-** You can create a recognizable identity for your service or product through Social Media, which is very important for a small business. By creating a brand and getting the word out, you are promoting online conversation.

2) Build relationships, create trust and be more personal- 78% of people surveyed trust peer reviews while only 14% trust traditional advertising. Social Media gives you a place to connect online and build that trust. (survey by Hoot-Suite)

3) Word of mouth- People trust their friends and loved ones more than anyone else. If your product is recommended by someone whose opinion is valued, chances are higher that it's your product they will buy.















4) Boost your customer service- These network channels give you the opportunity to track what people are saying about your product and services, listen to reviews and join the conversation to answer questions or fix any problems. This could be your first line of defense before incorrect rumors spread about your business.

**5) Small Business can compete with large companies-** In the past, competing with a large company's monstrous advertising budget was almost impossible for the small business. With the right type of online media, you could get an immense amount of sustainable traffic.

6) Get valuable product feedback- Through your online conversations with your customers, you can actively seek feedback and use this information to update or change your product.

7) Establish yourself as an expert- Your quick responses to questions from your customers will help you gain their trust. By joining forums or message boards, your answers will earn you respect as an expert in your field.

8) Valuable low cost marketing- Not many small businesses have a large advertising budget. With Social Media networks, most marketing can be done for free- except for your time.

**9) Communicate to a world of potential new customers-** Your one client in North Branch has 350 friends. If this client "likes" your Facebook page, your information will now show up on his friend's newsfeeds. This can start a web of potential new clients. (Keep in mind, if Facebook was a country, it would be the 3rd largest in the world. That's a lot of "Likes".)

**10)** Track and monitor your products, customers and competitors- Social Media tools will help you analyze data and monitor who is talking about your product. You can narrow it down to regions, specific terminology or campaigns. By having this data to review, you can see what changes need to be made.

2014 is a new year. It's time to start interacting in the world of Social Media with your business.
